Matthew 9:13 For I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners.

Matthew 9:37-38 "The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. #Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field."

Matthew 10:8 Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse those who have leprosy, drive out demons. Freely you have received, freely give.

Matthew 10:16 I am sending you out like sheep among wolves. Therefore be as shrewd as snakes and as innocent as doves.

Matthew 10:24-25 A student is not above his teacher, nor a servant above his master. #It is enough for the student to be like his teacher, and the servant like his master. If the head of the house has been called Beelzebub, how much more the members of his household !

Matthew 10:28 Do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather, be afraid of the one who can destroy both soul and body in hell.

Matthew 10:34-36 Do not suppose that I have come to bring peace to the earth. I did not come to bring peace, but a sword. #For I have come to turn "a man against his father, and a daughter against her mother, a daughter-in-law against her mother-in-law - #a man's

enemies will be the members of his own household."  
Matthew 11:28-30 Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. #Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. #For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.

Matthew 12:8 For the son of man is lord of the Sabbath.

Matthew 12:37 For by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned.

Matthew 12:39 He answered, "A wicked and adulterous generation asks for a sign! But none will be given it except the sign of the prophet Jonah."

Matthew 18:3-4 And he said: "I tell you the truth, unless you change and become like little children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven. #Therefore, whoever humbles himself like this child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven."

Matthew 18:6 But if anyone causes one of these little ones who believe in me to sin, it would be better for him to have a large millstone hung around his neck and to be drowned in the depths of the sea.

Matthew 18:18 I tell you the truth, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.

Matthew 18:20 For where two or three are gathered in my name, there am I with them.

Matthew 19:12 For some men are eunuchs because they were born that way; others were made that way by men; and others have renounced marriage because of the kingdom of heaven. The one who can accept this should accept it.

Matthew 19:14 Jesus said, "Let the little

children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these."

Matthew 21:22 If you believe, you will receive whatever you ask for in prayer.

Matthew 22:14 For many are called, but few are chosen.

Matthew 23:12 For whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and whoever humbles himself will be exalted.

Matthew 26:41 Watch and pray lest you enter into temptation. The spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak.

Matthew 26:52 "Put your sword in its place," Jesus said to him, "for all who draw the sword will die by the sword."

Matthew 28:18-20 Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and earth has been given to me. #Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the father and of the son and of the Holy Spirit, #teaching them to observe everything I have commanded you. And surely I will be with you always, to the very end of the age."

Mark 6:4 Jesus said to them, "Only in his home town, among his relatives and in his own house is a prophet without honor."

Mark 7:8 You have let go of the commands of God and are holding on to the traditions of men.

Mark 7:15 Nothing outside a man can make him "unclean" by going into him. Rather, it is what comes out of a man that makes him "unclean".

Mark 10:9 Therefore what God has joined together, let man not separate.

Mark 10:25 It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God.

Mark 12:17 Then Jesus said to them, "Give to Caesar what is Caesar's and to God what is God's." And they were amazed at him.

Mark 13:31 Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away.

Luke 1:46-55 And Mary said: "My soul magnifies the Lord #and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior, #for he has been mindful of the humble state of his servant. From now on all generations will call me blessed, #for the mighty one has done great things for me. His name is holy. #His mercy extends to those who fear him, from generation to generation. #He has performed mighty deeds with his arm; he has scattered those who are proud in their inmost thoughts. #He has brought down rulers from their thrones but he has lifted up the humble. #He has filled the hungry with good things but he has sent the rich away empty. #He has helped his servant Israel, remembering to be merciful #to Abraham and his descendants forever, even as he said to our fathers."

Luke 6:38 Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you.

Luke 6:39 He also told them this parable: "Can a blind man lead a blind man? Will they not both fall into a pit?["]

Luke 6:45 The good man brings good things out of the good stored up in his heart, and the evil man brings evil things out of the evil stored up in his heart. For out of the abundance of his heart his mouth speaks.

Luke 6:46 Why do you call me "Lord, Lord," and do not do what I

say?  
Luke 7:35 But wisdom is proved right by all her children.  
Luke 9:23-26 Then he said to them all: "If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me. #For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for me will save it. #What good is it for  
  
Luke 9:23-26 a man to gain the whole world, and yet lose or forfeit his very self? #If anyone is ashamed of me and my words, the son of man will be ashamed of him when he comes in his glory and in the glory of the father and of the holy angels.["]  
Luke 9:60 Jesus said to him, "Let the dead bury their own dead, but you go and proclaim the kingdom of God."  
Luke 9:62 Jesus replied, "No one who puts his hand to the plow and looks back is fit for service in the kingdom of God."  
Luke 10:18-20 He replied, "I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. #I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions, and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you. #However, do not rejoice that the spirits submit to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven."  
Luke 11:17 Jesus knew their thoughts and said to them: "Any kingdom divided against itself will be ruined, and a house divided against itself will fall.["]  
Luke 12:2-3 There is nothing concealed that will not be disclosed, or hidden that will not be made known. #What you have said in the dark will be heard in the daylight, and what you have whispered in the ear in the inner rooms will be proclaimed from the housetops.

Luke 12:15 Then he said to them, "Watch out! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; a man's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions."

Luke 14:26-30 If anyone comes to me and does not hate his father and mother, his wife and children, his brothers and sisters - yes, even his own life - he cannot be my disciple. #And anyone who does not carry his cross and follow me cannot be my disciple. #Suppose one of you wants to build a tower. Will he not first sit down and estimate the cost to see if he has enough money to complete it? #For if he lays the foundation and is not able to finish it, everyone who sees it will ridicule him, #saying, "This fellow began to build and was not able to finish."

Luke 15:7 I tell you that in the same way there will be more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent.

Luke 17:6 He replied, "If you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,' and it will be obey you.["]

Luke 17:21 [N]or will people say, "Here it is," or "There it is," because the kingdom of God is within you.

Luke 22:36 He said to them, "But now if you have a purse, take it, and also a bag; and if you don't have a sword, sell your cloak and buy one.["]

John 1:1-5 In the beginning was the word, and the word was with God, and the word was God. #He was with God in the beginning. #Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made. #In him was life, and the life was the light of men. #The light

John 2:19 "Destroy this temple, and I

John 3:16-17 For God so loved the world  
that he gave his one and only  
son, that whoever believes in  
him shall not perish but have

John 5:39-40 You diligently study the

#Therefore, my dear friends,  
as you have always obeyed -

works in you to will and to  
act according to his good  
purpose.

Philippians 3:8-9

What is more, I consider  
everything a loss compared to  
the surpassing greatness of  
knowing Christ Jesus my Lord,  
for whose sake I have lost all  
things. I consider them  
rubbish, that I may gain  
Christ #and be found in him,  
not having a righteousness of  
my own that comes from the  
law, but that which is through  
faith in Christ - the  
righteousness that comes from  
God and is by faith.

Philippians 4:7 And the peace of God which transcends all understanding will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

Philippians 4:11 I am not saying this because I am in need, for I have learned to be content whatever the circumstances.

Philippians 4:13 I can do everything through him who gives me strength.

Philippians 4:19 And my God will meet all your needs according to his glorious riches in Christ Jesus.

Colossians 1:17 He is before all things, and in him all things hold together.

Colossians 1:27 To them God has chosen to make known among the Gentiles the glorious riches of this mystery, which is CHRIST IN YOU, THE HOPE OF GLORY.

Colossians 2:6 So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live in him[.]

I Thessalonians 5:5 You are all sons of the light  
and sons of the day. We do  
not belong to the night or to  
the darkness. [children of  
the day]

I Thessalonians 5:9 For God did not appoint us to  
suffer wrath but to receive  
salvation through our Lord  
Jesus Christ.

I Thessalonians 5:16-22 Be joyful always; #pray  
continually; #give thanks in  
all circumstances, for this is  
God's will for you in Christ  
Jesus. #Do not put out the  
spirit's fire; #do not treat  
prophecies with contempt.  
#Test everything. Hold on to  
the good. #Avoid every kind  
of evil.

II Thessalonians 3:10 For even when we were with  
you, we gave you this rule:  
"If a man will not work, he  
shall not eat."

I Timothy 1:8-11 We know that the law is good  
if a man uses it properly.  
#We also know that law is made  
not for good men but for  
lawbreakers and rebels, the  
ungodly and sinful, the unholy  
and irreligious; for those who  
kill their fathers or mothers,  
for murderers, #for adulterers  
and perverts, for slave  
traders and liars and  
perjurers - and for whatever  
else is contrary to the sound  
doctrine #that conforms to the  
glorious gospel of the blessed

I Timothy 1:12 God, which he entrusted to me. That is why I am suffering as I am. Yet I am not ashamed, because I know whom I have believed, and am convinced that he is able to guard what I have entrusted to him for that day.

I Timothy 1:15 Here is a trustworthy saying that deserves full acceptance: Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners - of whom I am chief.

I Timothy 1:17 Now to the king eternal, immortal, invisible, the only God, be honor and glory for ever and ever. Amen.

I Timothy 2:5 For there is one God and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus[.]

I Timothy 2:8 I want men everywhere to lift up holy hands in prayer, without anger or disputing.

I Timothy 2:12 I do not permit a woman to teach or to have authority over a man; she must be silent.

I Timothy 3:15 [I]f I am delayed, you will know how people ought to conduct themselves in God's household, which is the church of the living God, THE PILLAR AND FOUNDATION OF TRUTH.

I Timothy 3:16 Beyond all question, the mystery of godliness is great: He appeared in a body, was vindicated by the spirit, was seen by angels, was preached among the nations, was believed on in the world, was taken up in glory.

I Timothy 4:1 The Spirit clearly says that in later times some will abandon the faith and follow deceiving spirits and things taught by demons.

I Timothy 4:8 For physical training is of some value, but godliness has value for all things, holding promise for both the present life and the life to come.

I Timothy 4:12 Don't let anyone look down on

you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in life, in love, in faith, and in purity.

I Timothy 5:8 If anyone does not provide for his relatives, and especially for his immediate family, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.

I Timothy 5:23 Stop drinking only water, and use a little wine because of your stomach and your frequent illnesses.

I Timothy 5:24 The sins of some men are obvious, reaching the place of judgment ahead of them; the sins of others trail behind them. #In the same way, good deeds are obvious, and even those that are not cannot be hidden. ..go before them ..

I Timothy 6:10 For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil, for which some have strayed from the faith in their greediness, and have pierced themselves with many sorrows.

II Timothy 1:6 For this reason I remind you to fan into flame the gift of God, which is in you through the laying on of my hands.

II Timothy 1:7 For God did not give us a spirit of cowardice but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

II Timothy 2:2 And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable men who will also be qualified to teach others.

II Timothy 2:3 Endure hardship with us like a good soldier of Christ Jesus.

II Timothy 2:9 [F]or which I am suffering even to the point of being chained like a criminal. But GOD'S WORD IS NOT CHAINED.

II Timothy 2:15 Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a workman who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth.

II Timothy 2:20-21 In a large house there are

articles not only of gold and silver, but also of wood and clay; some are for noble purposes and some for ignoble. #If a man cleanses himself from the latter, he will be an instrument for noble purposes, made holy, useful to the Master and prepared to do any good work.

II Timothy 2:23 Don't have anything to do with foolish and stupid arguments, because you know they produce quarrels.

II Timothy 3:12 And all who want to live godly in Christ Jesus will be persecuted.

II Timothy 3:16-17 All scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness, #so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.

II Timothy 4:3 For the time will come when men will not put up with sound doctrine. Instead, to suit their own desires, they will gather around them a great number of teachers to say what their itching ears want to hear.

II Timothy 4:7-8 I have fought the good fight; I have finished the race; I have kept the faith. #Now there is in store for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, will award to me on that day - and not only to me, but also to all who have longed for his appearing.

Titus 1:15 To the pure, all things are pure, but to those who are corrupted and do not believe, nothing is pure. In fact, both their minds and consciences are corrupted.

Titus 1:16 They claim to know God, but by their actions they deny him. They are detestable, disobedient, and unfit for doing anything good.

Hebrews 1:1-2 In the past God spoke to our

fathers through the prophets at many times and in various ways, #but in these last days he has spoken to us by his son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom he made the universe.

Hebrews 2:2 For if the message spoken by angels was binding, and every violation and disobedience received its just punishment, #how shall we escape if we ignore such a great salvation?

Hebrews 4:12 The word of God is living and powerful and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

Hebrews 4:15 For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are - yet was without sin.

Hebrews 4:16 Let us then approach the throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.

Hebrews 9:22 In fact, the law requires that nearly everything be cleansed with blood, and WITHOUT THE SHEDDING OF BLOOD THERE IS NO FORGIVENESS.

Hebrews 9:27 It is appointed for men to die once, and after this the judgment.

Hebrews 10:4 For it is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins.

Hebrews 10:25 Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another - and all the more as you see the day approaching.

Hebrews 10:31 It is a dreadful thing to fall into the hands of the living God.



Hebrews 11:1-2 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. #For by it the elders obtained a good testimony.

Hebrews 11:6 And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.

Hebrews 12:4 In your struggle against sin, you have not yet resisted to the point of shedding your blood.

Hebrews 13:4 Marriage should be honored by all, and the marriage bed kept pure, for God will judge the adulterer and all the sexually immoral.

Hebrews 13:5 Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have, because he has said, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you."

Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.

Hebrews 13:15 Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise - the fruit of lips that confess his name.

James 1:2-3 Count it all , my brothers, whenever you face trials of many kinds, #because you know that the testing of your faith develops steadfastness.

James 1:8 [H]e is a double-minded man, unstable in all he does.

James 1:17 Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows.

James 1:20 Man's anger does not produce the righteousness of God.

James 1:22 Be doers of the word and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves.

James 2:13 [B]ecause judgment without mercy will be shown to anyone who has not been merciful.

James 3:1 Mercy triumphs over judgment !  
Not many of you should presume  
to be teachers, my brothers,  
because you know that we who  
teach will be judged more  
strictly.

James 4:4 You adulterous people, don't  
you know that friendship with  
the world is hatred toward  
God?

James 4:7 Submit yourselves, then, to  
God. Resist the devil, and he  
will flee from you.

James 4:10 Humble yourselves before the  
Lord, and he will lift you up.

James 4:17 Anyone, then, who knows the  
good he ought to do and  
doesn't do it, sins.

I Peter 1:8 Though you have not seen him,  
you love him; and even though  
you do not see him now, you  
believe in him and are filled  
with an inexpressible and  
glorious joy[.]

I Peter 1:16 But just as he who called you  
is holy, so be holy in all you  
do; #for it is written: "Be  
holy, because I am holy."

I Peter 2:9 But you are a chosen  
generation, a royal  
priesthood, a holy nation, his  
own special people, that you  
may proclaim the praises of  
him who called you out of  
darkness into his marvelous  
light.

I Peter 2:11 Dear friends, I urge you, as  
aliens and strangers in the  
world, to abstain from sinful  
desires, which war against  
your soul.

II Peter 3:9 The Lord is not slow in  
keeping his promise, as some  
understand slowness. He is  
patient with you, not wanting  
anyone to perish, but everyone  
to come to repentance.

I Peter 3:15 But in your hearts acknowledge  
Christ as the holy Lord.  
Always be prepared to give an  
answer to everyone who asks  
you to give the reason for the  
hope that you have.

I Peter 4:8 Above all, love each other

deeply, because LOVE COVERS  
OVER A MULTITUDE OF SINS.

I Peter 4:12-13 Dear friends, do not be surprised at the painful trial you are suffering, as though something strange were happening to you. #But rejoice that you participate in the sufferings of Christ, so that you may be overjoyed when his glory is revealed.

I Peter 5:5b "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble".

I Peter 5:7 Cast all your anxiety upon him because he cares for you.

I Peter 5:8 Be self-controlled and alert. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour.

II Peter 1:3 His divine power has given us everything we need for life and godliness through our knowledge of him who called us by his own glory and goodness.

II Peter 1:20-21 Above all, you must understand that no prophecy of scripture came about by the prophet's own interpretation. #For prophecy never had its origin in the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit.

II Peter 2:9 [I]f this is so, then the Lord knows how to rescue godly men from trials and to hold the unrighteous for the day of judgment, while continuing their punishment.

II Peter 3:8 But do not forget this one thing, dear friends: With the Lord a day is like a thousand years, and a thousand years are like a day.

I John 1:5-10 This is the message we have heard from him and declare to you: God is light; in him there is no darkness at all. #If we claim to have fellowship with him yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not live by the truth. #But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have

fellowship with one another,  
and the blood of Jesus, his  
son, purifies us from every  
sin. #If we claim to be  
without sin, we deceive  
ourselves and the truth is not  
in us. #If we confess our  
sins, he is faithful and just  
and will forgive us our sins  
and purify us from all  
unrighteousness. #If we claim  
we have not sinned, we make  
him out to be a liar and his  
word has no place in our  
lives.

I John 2:1-2

My little children, I am  
writing these things to you so  
that you will not sin. And if  
anyone sins, we have an  
advocate with the father:  
Jesus Christ the righteous  
[one]. #He is the  
propitiation for our sins, and  
not for ours only but also for  
the sins of the whole world.

I John 2:3

We know that we have come to  
know him if we obey his  
commands.

I John 2:9

Whoever says that he is in the  
light and hates his brother is  
still in darkness.

I John 2:15-17

Do not love the world or the  
things in the world. If  
anyone loves the world, the  
love of the father is not in  
him. #For everything that is  
in the world - the lust of the  
flesh, the lust of the eyes,  
and the pride of life - is not  
from the father, but is from  
the world. #The world and its  
lusts are passing away, but  
whoever does the will of God  
remains forever.

I John 2:27

But the anointing that you  
received from him remains in  
you, and you don't need anyone  
to teach you. But as his  
anointing teaches you about  
everything, and is true, and  
is not a lie, and as it taught  
you - remain in him.

I John 3:1-3

See what kind of love the  
father has given to us, that

we may be called the children of God- and we are. Therefore the world does not know us, because it did not know him. #Beloved, now we are the children of God, and what we will be has not yet appeared; but we know that when it does appear, we will be like him, because we will see him as he is. #And everyone having this hope in [Jesus] purifies himself, just as [Jesus] is pure.

- I John 3:4 Everyone who sins breaks the law; in fact, sin is lawlessness.
- I John 3:17 If anyone has this world's goods and sees his brother in need and has no compassion on him, how does God's love remain in him?
- I John 3:18 Dear children, let us not love with words or tongue but with actions and in truth.
- I John 4:4 You, dear children, are from God and have overcome them, because the ONE WHO IS IN YOU IS GREATER THAN THE ONE WHO IS IN THE WORLD.
- I John 4:7-8 Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God. Everyone who loves is begotten of God and knows God. #One who does not love does not know God, because God is love.
- I John 4:10 This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins.
- I John 4:18 There is no fear in love; but perfect love drives out fear, because fear has to do with punishment. The man who fears is not made perfect in love.
- I John 5:4 [F]or everyone born of God has overcome the world. This is the victory that has overcome the world, even our faith.
- I John 5:13 I write these things to you who believe in the name of the son of God so that you may know that you have eternal

And this is love: that we walk in obedience to his commands. As you have heard from the beginning, his command is that you walk in love.
